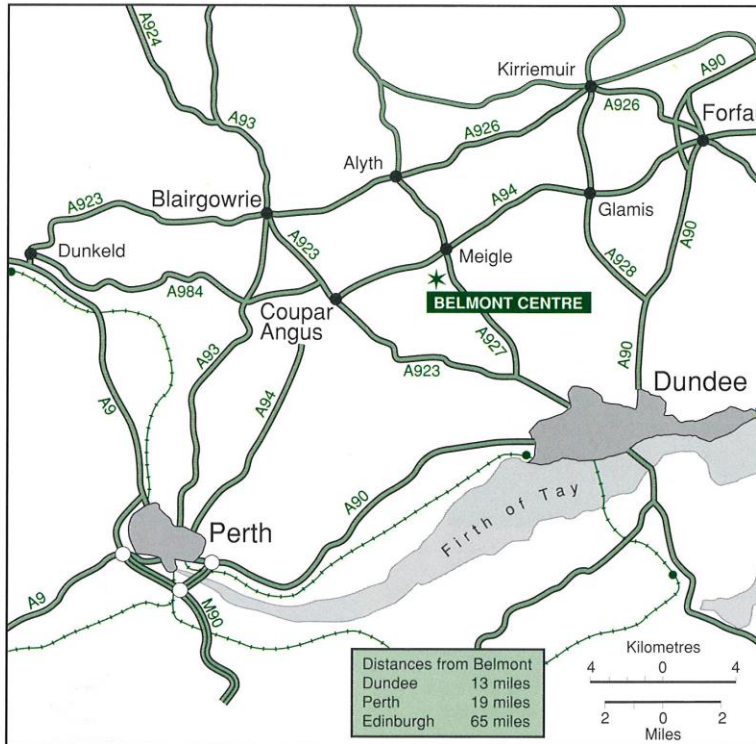

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Programme

Friday 24 September 2010 (PM)	Sprint
Saturday 25 September 2010	Relay
Sunday 26 September 2010	Long Distance

Participants

The Junior European Cup is open to national teams for competitors no older than 20 years of age on 31 December 2010. Entries will be limited to 150 athletes and priority will be given to early entry submissions. Maximum 4 staff per nation.

Classes

Sprint/Long Distance races: W18, M18, W20, M20

A maximum of 6 runners per national team in each class (24 max)

Relay: Men/Women

As many teams as can be made up from your above entry.

Terrain Description

Sprint: University campus and urban mix at St.Andrews, home of golf!

Relay: A typically Scottish mixed woodland, Faskally, Pitlochry

Long Distance: Forested, low-lying sand dunes at Tenstmuir.

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Embargoed areas

As of now the forests of Tenstmuir and Faskally are embargoed for orienteering activities. The map at St.Andrews is brand new.

Electronic Punching System

SportIdent system will be used in all JEC 2010 races. SI cards can be hired on request (please state in your entry).

Costs

Competitor: £150

Team Official: £130

Includes entries to all 3 competitions, maps, accommodation, meals from Friday 24 September dinner to packed lunch on Sunday 26 September. There will be no reduction for later arrivals.

It is possible to arrive on the Thursday afternoon and accommodation with evening meal, breakfast, packed lunch and training map for Friday morning will cost £35.

Entries

Indicative Entries are to be received as soon as possible using the form on the website. Remember that places at JEC 2010 are based on a first-come-first served response basis!

Preliminary Entries with £50 deposit per participant (including staff) to be submitted by 31 May 2010. This is a mandatory declaration of numbers and the deposits are non-refundable.

Final Entries with final amounts due to be submitted by 31 July 2010.

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Training

Training can be organised before and after JEC 2010. There are a variety of terrains in Scotland and within one hour of JEC 2010. The best terrains and availability of maps can be found in Speyside, 90 minutes to the north. Transport

The organisers cannot provide any transport for any part of JEC 2010. Please arrange your own flights and travel to JEC. Many car hire company links can be found at the appropriate airport website.

Flights into Scotland

The nearest airport is Edinburgh – 80 minutes from the accommodation and 70 minutes from the Sprint.

Glasgow International is 2 hours from the accommodation and 1:45 from the Sprint.

Glasgow Prestwick is 2:30 from the accommodation and 2:15 from the sprint.
