Terrain – The area is a compact mix of forest and open with the remains of Roughcastle Roman fort and the Antonine wall providing some interesting contour features. There are many paths of varying visibility. Courses will not take you near to the canal.

Timing System – SPORTIdent will be used. Touch free punching will be activated.
