Courses

- Yellow - 1.7km - easy navigation. Mostly on paths. Ideal for children who haven't done any/much orienteering before
- Orange - 2.5km - moderate navigation, some controls are off the path, suitable for adult beginners and families with children who can walk for an hour
- Short Green - 3.4km - difficult navigation, suitable for intermediate/experienced orienteers
- Green – 4.1km - difficult navigation, suitable for intermediate/experienced orienteers
- Blue – 6.5km - difficult navigation, suitable for experienced orienteers looking for a longer run
- Brown – 8.6km - difficult navigation, suitable for experienced orienteers looking for an even longer run

Courses close: 14.00 - all participants **MUST** report to the finish by that time.

- Orange - Junior Boys (M12+) & Junior Girls (W12+)
- Yellow - Young Junior Boys (M10) & Young Junior Girls (W10)
