

Holme Hill Santa Score - Saturday 23 December - Final Details

This is a fun, festive themed event for juniors and young families. Suitable for both beginners to orienteering, and the more experienced.



Location and Directions: Braeport Centre, Dunblane FK15 OAT

Car Parking: At the Braeport Centre. If full, please use the nearby Dunblane Cathedral car park. See map opposite for parking locations – marked with a 'P'. Otherwise street parking, but please be considerate of local residents.

Meet at Braeport Centre by 1.10pm at latest, to collect dibbers.

Start: Mass Start at 1.30pm. Start is at the Braeport street entrance to Holme Hill, just 1 minute's walk from the Braeport Centre. **There will be a short briefing before the start.**

Aim: Visit as many controls are you can in 30 minutes. There is even a roaming Santa control. Points awarded for every control found. Beware, there are points deducted if you finish after 30 minutes! Prizes for those back first with most points.

Finish: is at same location as start – but note need to download as per below.

Download: all participants MUST go to Braeport and download, even if you don't finish. This is for safety reasons. Participants also need to download to get a result.

Course closes: 2.15pm

Course length: optimum length if all controls are visited is 2.5km with 8om climb Technical difficulty varies but average of TD₃.

Map: 1:2000. Woodland terrain. All within the boundaries of Holme Hill.

Equipment Needed: **WEAR A WATCH** or use the timer on your phone. You will need this to know when the 30 minutes is almost up. If you have your own compass, please bring this. Otherwise there is the option to borrow one at the Braeport Centre. **If you have hired an SI dibber (when entering the event), this should be collected at the Braeport Centre at least 20 minutes before the mass start.**



Prizes: Santa hats for all participants. Medals for all junior participants. Additional prizes for winners, and some spot prizes too!

Toilets: At Braeport Centre

Refreshments: Hot drinks for sale at the Braeport Centre, during and immediately after the event.

Safety:

- 1. Marshals will man the exits of Holme Hill, and the short road route to and from the start/finish and the Braeport Centre. For safety, please follow all Marshal's instructions.
- 2. Please take care of other members of the public using the area eg dog walking, bike riding etc.
- 3. A comprehensive risk assessment has been carried out by the organiser, but participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.
- 4. You have the option of downloading, completing and handing this <u>Medical Form</u> to the Organiser (at Braeport Centre) so that existing medical conditions are known about in the event of an incident. Please put in a sealed envelope with your name on it. It will only be opened if required and will be destroyed unread if you don't collect before the end of the event.
- 5. Everyone must download at the finish, whether or not you have completed the course.
- 6. If you have covid, or covid symptoms, or a recent positive covid test please do not attend the event.
- 7. First aid kit and officer will be on location at Braeport Centre.
- 8. In the event of bad weather, the organiser may cancel the event. If this is the case, notice will be given on the FVO Website, which may be as late as the morning of the event.
