My Life of Lyme

Most orienteers are aware of Lyme Disease, caused by an infection from a tick bite. In case you're not, since I've just had a dose of it, I thought it might be useful to remind you.

I've always got a lot of tick bites, and as a consequence never thought too much about them. I've become adept at picking ticks out with my thumbnails, and almost always they come out cleanly. The 6 Days brought its usual crop, and I thought little of it until one morning 3 weeks later when I found a circular red rash around the site of a tick bite. After that, my suggestible, middle-aged hypochondriac brain clicked in, and various things from the preceding couple of weeks fitted - a run where I never got going and simply felt leaden, a run where I did get going but seemed to be going half my normal speed.


So off to my GP, who knew immediately why I was there, couldn't confirm the diagnosis without a blood test, but on the balance of probabilities prescribed 14 days of antibiotics there and then. After 3 days of antibiotics, I was feeling a lot better, and 5 days later ran an interval session feeling a lot better. 3 weeks later, a phone call from the surgery confirmed the diagnosis from a positive blood test.

So, what lessons are there to learn? Firstly, having caught it early, there are likely to be no lasting effects. I don't expect to change what I do, but I will keep an eye out for future ticks. Most ticks do not carry the disease, and apparently the bacterium only gets transferred to you if the tick stays in for 24 hours. So, keep checking for ticks and taking them out - this one was on my back near my waist - not one of the usual dark crevices!

Finally, in a strange way, it's nice to know you're not just being a hypochondriac - don't ask about my "heart condition" or my "bowel cancer"!


